Evidently, candidates must have a demonstrated ability in most if not all the seven areas. While it is mandatory for all candidates to have a strong research and publication record, candidates at Associate/Full Professor level must have a record of publications in quality journals

Selected candidates would be expected to teach in the various programmes (including executive PGP and doctoral programmes), conduct research and publish in top class journals, engage in consultancy and training, and shoulder academic administration tasks.

Number of vacancies may increase /decrease.

Eligibility Criteria

Minimum Qualification (for all faculty positions): Ph.D. in appropriate branch with first class or equivalent (in terms of grades, etc.) at the preceding degree, with a very good academic record throughout. In addition, for:

Professor: Minimum 10 years teaching/research/industrial experience of which at least 4 years should be at the level of Associate Professor in IITs, IIMs, NITIE, IISc Bangalore, NITIE Mumbai and IISERs or at an equivalent level in any Indian or foreign institution of comparable standard.

Associate Professor: Minimum six years teaching/research/industrial experience of which at least three years should be at the level of Assistant Professor or equivalent.

Assistant Professor: Minimum three years of teaching/research/industrial experience (exclusive of period doing Ph.D.). A fresh Ph.D. may be considered for the position on contract basis.
