1. Bids in sealed cover two-bid system are invited for a rate contract from reputed, experienced and financially sound parties for Cafeteria Services at IIM Kashipur. Please super scribe the outer cover of the sealed bid as “CAFETERIA SERVICES AT IIM KASHIPUR”, NIT/01 dated 13.05.2026, to avoid the Bid being declared invalid. Bids not super-scribed with the details mentioned above may be declared invalid.

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3. **Cost of Bid Document/Tender Fee:** NIL. Bidders can download the bid document from the website of IIM Kashipur. Please keep visiting our website for any corrigendum/amendments and submit the bid document accordingly.
4. **Estimated Volume of Business** The yearly total estimated business volume is approximately Rs. 2,00,00,000/- (Rupees Two Crore approximately).
3. **Earnest Money Deposit:** 26,000/-
4. **Security Deposit:** Rs. 1 Lakh
5. **Manner of depositing the Bids:** Sealed Bids should be either dropped in the Tender Box placed at the Main Gate of IIM Kashipur or should be sent by registered post/courier at the address given above to reach by the due date and time. Late tenders will not be considered. No responsibility will be taken for postal/courier delay or non-delivery/non-receipt of Bid documents. Bids sent by FAX or e-mail will not be considered.
6. The NIT may be signed on all the pages by the bidder. Buyer also reserves the right to withdraw the NIT, should it become necessary at any stage to withdraw the NIT.
7. The Bidders may depute their representatives, duly authorized in writing, to attend the opening of Bids on the due date and time. This event will not be postponed due to the non-attendance of your representative.
8. **Forwarding of Bids** – Bids should be forwarded by Bidders in a sealed envelope by duly superscribed as stipulated above. The Bid should contain a copy of the NIT document duly signed and may be stamped on each page along with a demand draft of EMD as specified above and all the documentary proofs to establish eligibility and their potential of professional readiness for the services.
9. **Clarification regarding contents of the NIT:** A prospective bidder who requires clarification regarding the contents of the bidding documents shall notify to the Buyer in writing or telephonically about the clarifications sought not later than two days prior to the date of opening of the Bids.
10. **Modification and Withdrawal of Bids:** A bidder may modify or withdraw his bid after submission, provided that the written notice of modification or withdrawal is received by the Buyer prior to the deadline prescribed for submission of bids. A withdrawal notice should on a signed confirmation copy to be sent by post and such signed confirmation should reach the purchaser not later than the deadline for submission of bids. No bid shall be modified after the deadline for submission of bids. No bid may be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of bids and the expiration of the period of bid validity specified. Withdrawal of a bid during this period will result in the Bidder's forfeiture of bid security.



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11. **Rejection of Bids:** Canvassing by the Bidder in any form, unsolicited letter and post-tender correction may invoke summary rejection with forfeiture of EMD. Conditional tenders will be rejected.
12. **Validity of Bids:** The Bids should remain valid till **90 days** from the last date of submission of the Bids.
13. **SCOPE OF WORK:**
 - (a) The period of the contract shall be initially for three years, which may be extended annually on satisfactory performance of the vendor and on mutual consent of both parties. Proposed date of commencement of the Work/Contract: **01st Jul 2026**.
 - (b) The Contractor shall fulfill all the obligations arising under the contract and shall not enter into a sub-contract with other party/parties. He shall have no right to tenancy, demise or any interest whatsoever in respect of said premises.
 - (c) The Contractor shall supply quality foodstuffs, beverages and other refreshments to the satisfaction of the Institute. The Institute has the right to inspect the materials used by the Contractor periodically and impound any items, the quality of which is found substandard. The Institute is also entitled to insist on branded materials to be used for the preparation of food/beverages. Only fresh items like vegetables etc., shall be used.
 - (d) All items of food, raw materials for food purchased will have to conform to the standards prescribed under the Prevention of Food Adulteration Act, and/or any other Act applicable and as far as possible shall have the standards/branded bearing the mark "Agmark", ISI , FSSAI as applicable.
 - (e) The Contractor shall use the Electrical cooking range and other similar equipment of its own. LPG is not to be used in an academic area. The Contractor shall arrange all items such as a refrigerator, cutlery, crockery, utensils and other equipment to be installed in the kitchen and other requirements for running the Canteen. The contractor will take all necessary precautions towards safety as per government guidelines and fire hazards.
 - (f) The rate list and menu as approved by the Institute should be displayed clearly. Any change in the rate list or item should be duly approved by the Institute authority. Items mentioned in the approved rate list are only to be kept in the canteen. No special item to be prepared and supplied by the contractor. The menu as per Appendix II. All packed items are not sold above MRP.
 - (g) Surprise visits to the canteen will be made by the Institute's officials from time to time to inspect the canteen premises to check the quality of food, services and cleanliness of the canteen. The contractors must cooperate for all such inspections. If required, feedback from the users could be obtained anytime.



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- (h) The Canteen will function from 09:00 am to 12:00 am and may change as per the requirements of the institute. Timings could be flexible but with prior permission from the Institute authority. Canteen shall be kept open on all the days during the period when the Classes, training courses or seminars etc., are conducted by the Institute and on such other days as may be indicated by the Institute.
- (i) The contractor shall maintain all the items, including equipment, utensils, cooking area and surroundings in proper and hygienic conditions. The Contractor shall store foodstuffs, drinking water and other articles in a hygienic condition. The contractor shall also maintain a list of kitchen equipment, utensils and other appliances installed in the canteen at his own cost and shall produce such list to the institute whenever required. The contractor shall store the foodstuffs, drinking water and other articles in a hygienic condition as per food and safety norms.
- (j) The Contractor shall arrange proper bins for throwing refuse/waste from the canteen and arrange at his own cost for regular, prompt and proper removal of such refuse from the Institute, every day. The good quality and adequate size of bins to be placed at appropriate place(s) at cafeteria as notified by the estate department of the institute.
- (k) The contractor and his staff deployed shall adhere to the institute's discipline norms and in no case shall disturb the working of the institute and follow the instructions issued from time to time in this connection.
- (l) Requisite staff of the canteen contractor will be allowed to stay in the canteen after working hours (under special circumstances) only with prior permission from the administration of the Institute, and no unauthorized person shall be allowed to stay in the canteen.
- (m) The Contractor shall employ at his own expenses efficient and experienced persons for supervision and working of the Canteen and an adequate number of helpers/stewards. The Contractor shall ensure that such servants employed by him shall be free from diseases, clean, courteous and neatly dressed.
- (n) The contractor shall have no right to sublease the contract or entrust the work to anyone else without the written permission of the Institute.
- (o) The contractor shall strictly adhere to:
 - (i) Child Labor Abolition Act
 - (ii) Essential Commodities Act
 - (iii) Food and Beverages Act
 - (iv) State Guest Contract Act or any other Act as applicable from time to time



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- (p) The possession of the premises will always be that of IIM Kashipur even when the premises are in the use of the contractor.
- (q) No employee/student/outsideers will be allowed to smoke or consume alcohol/ banned or abused drugs in the canteen. The contractor shall not keep or sell any tobacco products or health hazard articles.
- (r) The said premises shall not be utilized for any purpose other than for the purpose of running the Canteen. The Contractor shall not make or permit to be made without the prior permission in writing of the Institute, any structural alterations or additions of any kind, either temporarily or permanently to the said premises.
- (s) The contractor is required to pay the electricity and allied charges per month as per the norms of the institute. The rent as finalised will be paid by the contractor before 10th day of every month. The delay in payment of the same will invite a penalty of Rs. 100/- (Rupees One Hundred only) per day.
- (t) The Institute reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time after getting a recommendation of an independently appointed committee against any serious complaint(s) regarding the performance/maintenance of the canteen. The committee shall consist of at least one student and a non-teaching staff representative of an adequate level as a member and the decision taken by the competent authority on the recommendation of the committee in this regard shall be final.
- (u) The contractor shall be responsible for the recovery of dues, if any, towards any person/student of the Institute. It is advised not to encourage the credit system. Steps should be taken to promote digital transactions as per the government orders.
- (v) Payment for the rent will be made monthly after submission of bills in duplicate for the month.
- (w) The contract can be terminated either by the Institute or the Contractor by giving a minimum of three months' notice. In case the contractor violates the terms & conditions of the contract, his contract would be cancelled without any notice.
- (x) The price of the food articles may be revised after one year as per the prevailing market rate.

15. All allotments shall be made only on a higher rent basis. However, before the occupation of the shops, the allottee, after getting the allotment letter, the allottee shall have to submit the following:

- (i) Performance Guarantee as prescribed is to be deposited in advance before occupation. It will be refunded on successful completion of the tenure of the contract.



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- (ii) Execute a lease agreement in the prescribed Performa on stamped paper worth Rs. 100/-. Self-Police verification and the police verification of the employees are to be submitted at the earliest to the institute.
- (iii) All formalities in respect of allotment of shop, like signing inventory of fixtures (electrical and civil), etc., shall be completed by the allottee within 30 working days or as time prescribed for allotment.

16. **ARBITRATION:** Except as otherwise provided elsewhere the contract, if any dispute, difference, question or disagreement or matter whatsoever, shall, before/after completion or abandonment of work or during extended period, hereafter arises between the parties, as to the meaning, operation or effect of the contract or out of or relating to the contract or breach thereof, shall be referred to a Sole Arbitrator to be appointed by mutual understanding of both the parties. If the arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred dies or refuses to act or resigns/withdraws for any reason from the position of arbitration, it shall be lawful for the IIM Kashipur to appoint another person to act as Arbitrator in the manner aforesaid. Such person shall be entitled to proceed with reference from the stage at which his predecessor left it, if both the parties' consent to this effect, failing which the Arbitrator shall be entitled to proceed *denovo*. It is a term of the contract that the party invoking arbitration shall specify all disputes to be referred to Arbitrator at the time of invocation of arbitration under this clause. It is also term of the contract that the cost of arbitration shall be borne by the parties themselves. The venue of arbitration shall invariably be at Kashipur. Subject as aforesaid the provisions of the Arbitration and conciliation Act 1996 and any statutory modifications or re-enactment thereof or rules made there under and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause. If any dispute arising out of this agreement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Kashipur.

17. **Termination of Contract:** - IIM Kashipur shall at any time be entitled to determine and terminate the contract for any reason, including unsatisfactory performance or violation of the terms and conditions of the Agreement and/or any contract whatsoever. A notice in writing from IIM Kashipur to the Company/ Agency shall be served, giving 30 (thirty) days' time for such termination and vacation of the premises, without assigning any reasons thereof. In the event of any breach, delay or unsatisfactory performance on the part of the Agency, IIM Kashipur may, without prejudice to its other rights, claims, entitlements etc., terminate this Agreement if such breach, delay or performance is not cured by the Consultant within 15 days from the date of receipt of notice.

18. **No joint venture:** Nothing contained in this Agreement shall be deemed or construed as creating a joint venture or partnership between the Institute and Agency. Neither Party shall have the power to control the activities and operation of the other Party or bind the other Party, and their status is and at all times will continue to be that of independent entities with respect to each other.

19. **Governing Law:** This Agreement shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the law governing such matters in India.



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21. **Evaluation Criteria** - The broad guidelines for evaluation of Bids will be as follows:

- a) **Mandatory FSSAI License:** In compliance with the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006, it is proposed to mandatorily require a valid FSSAI License for all bidders. This applies to all food business operators, including those operating in industrial, school, college, and institutional canteens, to ensure food safety and regulatory compliance.
- b) **Broadened Past Experience criteria:** The work executed for Central/State Government and PSUs, and also for Private Firms and Major Industrial Campuses.
- c) **Annual Menu Computation:** The menu will be computed on an annual basis to ensure uniformity in pricing, better financial planning, and operational clarity for both the Institute and the service provider.
- d) **The Contractor should have legal status, whether a registered Partnership Firm or a Company registered under the Companies Act, having a legal entity with all statutory licenses/registrations required for carrying out catering activities, including registrations for tax liabilities such as GST, Income Tax, and other statutory compliances. Copies of GST and other licenses/registrations are to be attached to the NIT.**
- (e) **The average annual turnover of the firm for the last three financial years should be greater than or equal to Rs. 1,00,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore only). Bidders are mandatorily required to furnish relevant documentary evidence in support of their financial soundness as part of the bid submission.**
- (f) **The bidder must have at least three (03) years' experience in providing similar types of catering services and should have executed at least one similar service during the last three years to any Central/State Government / PSU / Private Firm / Major Industrial Campus. Documentary proof indicating the nature and duration of services rendered shall be furnished.**
- (g) **There should be no criminal case pending with the police against the Proprietor/Firm/Partner(s)/Company, and the firm should not be blacklisted by any Central/State Government, PSU, or any other institution. A self-declaration to this effect, as incorporated in the bid, shall be deemed sufficient – Annexure D.**
- (h) **Monthly rent will be Rs. 35,000/- (Rs. Thirty-Five Only) inclusive of taxes and will be increased by 5% annually, excluding the electricity bill. The tender may be awarded to the party that will quote the highest rent, and the rates of the items should be as per the attached menu rates.**



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- (j) The canteen run timing will be 9 AM to 12 AM.
- (k) The menu items and their pricing will be reviewed and negotiable annually (if required).
- (l) Initially, the agreement will be valid for three (03) years and may be extended further up to two (02) years on the same terms and conditions, subject to a satisfactory service report.
- (m) Only those Bids will be evaluated which are found to be fulfilling all the eligibility and qualifying requirements of the NIT. The Bids forwarded by the Bidders will be evaluated with reference to the eligibility characteristics of the NIT. The compliance of Bids shall be determined based on the parameters specified in the NIT and the financial evaluation in total.
- (n) **The successful Bidder will be decided upon the highest rent quoted by the particular Bidder as per the Format on Annexure - I.**
- (o) All the rates/rent quoted should be inclusive of all taxes.



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Penalty / Liquidated Damages Clause

(As per GeM Terms & Conditions and Bid Conditions)

1. Delay in Payment of Monthly License Fee / Rent

The contractor shall deposit the monthly license fee/rent, electricity charges, water charges, and any other applicable dues on or before the 10th day of every month or as specified by the Institute. In case of delay in payment, the following action shall be taken:

a) Delay beyond 30 days:

Interest @ 5% per month shall be charged on the outstanding amount of license fee/rent and utility charges.

b) Delay beyond 60 days:

In addition to the above interest, the Institute shall have the right to issue a notice for suspension/termination of the contract and recover dues from the Security Deposit/Performance Security.

c) Continuous Default:

Repeated non-payment or habitual delay in payment shall be treated as breach of contract and action may be initiated as per GeM General Terms & Conditions, including termination of contract and blacklisting/debarment, if deemed fit by the competent authority.

2. Penalty for Non-Maintenance of Hygiene & Sanitation

The contractor shall maintain proper cleanliness, hygiene, pest control, food safety standards, waste disposal, and sanitation in the kitchen, dining hall, pantry, service counters, utensils, storage areas, and surrounding premises strictly in accordance with FSSAI norms, local statutory requirements, and Institute standards.

In case any deficiency is observed during inspection by the Institute authorities/committee, the following penalties may be imposed:

- **First Instance:** Written warning with immediate rectification directions.
- **Second Instance:** Penalty of ₹5,000/- per violation.
- **Third Instance and Subsequent Violations:** Penalty up to ₹25,000/- per violation.
- **Serious Violations:** The Institute may suspend operations partially or fully and/or terminate the contract in case of unhygienic conditions adversely affecting health and safety.

3. Penalty for Poor Quality Food / Service Deficiency

The contractor shall ensure that food items supplied are fresh, hygienic, safe for consumption, and as per the approved menu/specifications.

If food quality is found to be substandard, stale, contaminated, adulterated, improperly cooked, or not conforming to approved standards/menu, penalty up to ₹10,000/- per instance may be imposed depending upon the severity of the lapse.

The Institute may also order immediate disposal/replacement of such food items at the contractor's risk and cost.

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4. Non-Performance / Interruption of Services

Failure to provide services as per schedule, non-availability of approved food items, inadequate manpower deployment, closure of services without permission, or interruption of catering operations without prior approval of the Institute shall attract suitable penalty/action as decided by the competent authority.

In severe or repeated cases, the Institute may make alternative arrangements at the risk and cost of the contractor.

5. Violation of Statutory Requirements

The contractor shall comply with all applicable statutory provisions including FSSAI regulations, labour laws, fire safety norms, EPF/ESI provisions, and municipal regulations.

Any penalty imposed by statutory authorities due to non-compliance attributable to the contractor shall be borne entirely by the contractor and may also attract additional penalty/action by the Institute.

6. Recovery of Penalty

The penalty amount and any other dues recoverable from the contractor may be adjusted/recovered from:

- Pending bills/payments of the contractor; and/or
- Security Deposit/Performance Security; and/or
- Any other amount payable to the contractor by the Institute.


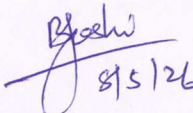
7. Termination Clause

Repeated defaults, unsatisfactory performance, breach of tender conditions, non-compliance with GeM contractual obligations, or failure to comply with directions issued by the Institute may lead to termination of the contract and forfeiture of Security Deposit/Performance Security, in accordance with GeM General Terms & Conditions and Institute rules.

The Institute shall also have the right to terminate the contract at any time by giving 03 (three) months' notice without assigning any reason.

8. Decision of the Institute

The decision of the Institute regarding assessment of deficiencies, imposition of penalties, interpretation of contractual provisions, and adequacy of services shall be final and binding upon the contractor.
